### **And it's Alright Now**

Sometimes the whole goody-goody thing can be grating, but **P.J. Pacifico** sure sounds sincere on his new album ***Well I'll Be***. He's releasing it with a show at **Acoustic Café** tonight, and it's full of warm sentiment. Musically, he falls somewhere between earnest pop and new country--he's got a warbling, light voice that leads each personally-penned song. It begins with "Another Me," which starts with a musical nod to Southern rock, and includes his feelings about finding someone special and how "patience leads to everything." "Okay Fine" picks up a bit more twangy country in the guitar and a livelier beat as Pacifico muses, "And I said, alright, okay, fine, I stumbled over a goldmine." Some of it's sappy, but Pacifico has a clean, easy style and an understated band to match who hold the rhythm steady behind his capable singing. Formerly, he co-fronted **Sunflower**, but Pacifico sounds just as comfortable on his own.
